This course will review the termination requirements in Article 110.14 and other rules pertaining to terminations. Participants in this course will solve problems to help refine their understanding of the calculations used for conductor installations as they relate to Article 310, Chapter 9 and other sections of the NEC®.

1. Registration deadline is 2 weeks prior to the class start. This allows ample time to order and receive textbooks and workbooks prior to the start of class.
  - a. Pre-registration for all course offerings is required.
  - b. Please note that all courses have a minimum enrollment number for the course to commence. As a result, all course schedules are subject to change and/or cancelation.
2. The Madison Area Electrical Joint Apprenticeship and Training Trust Committee will provide Continuing Education courses at IBEW Local 159's Training Center with no tuition cost for members in all classifications.
  - a. Effective July 28, 2015, the Madison Area Electrical Joint Apprenticeship and Training Trust has ended their Course Tuition Reimbursement Policy for all classifications except Inside (Construction) Apprentices, and Voice, Data, Video Apprentices.
3. The training trust fund will provide the necessary textbooks for use in the courses. The textbooks are to be returned at the completion of the course. The textbooks are available for purchase upon request.
  - a. Attendees that fail to return or provide payment for the textbooks will be prohibited from registering for future classes until the matter is resolved.
  - b. Attendees that wish to purchase the course materials must do so before retaining possession of the materials. (No billing; must be paid in full with check or money order prior to the conclusion of the course).
4. UPON DEMAND classes all maintain an active waiting list of members that are interested in taking the course. When enough names are on the waiting list, a firm start date will be set and the Class Schedule will be updated.
